



What is a Florida Product Approval (FPA)?

A FPA is an optional program instituted by the Florida Building Commission to aid local building officials in the approval of products. Products that are approved by the Commission cannot be rejected by the local jurisdiction. Without the approval, it is up to each local jurisdiction to approve the product independently. FPAs tell building officials and other Florida building professionals that the product is approved by the Commission for use in the state. Meeting stringent Florida Product Approval process requirements mean that our building system has passed rigorous testing standards set by the state of Florida and are approved for use in High Velocity Hurricane Zones.
